WHAT IS A MEGA TRANSPORT?

A Mega Transport is when our shelter receives a large group of kittens from other shelters that are unable to care for them. We typically receive information about the kittens—such as their ages, any known illnesses, and vaccination status—the day before they arrive.

WILL I GET AN EMAIL OR TEXT CONFIRMING MY PICKUP?

No. Once you sign up on the spreadsheet, we expect you to arrive on the day of the Mega Transport.

CAN I PICK THE KITTENS I WANT TO FOSTER?

Yes and no. Since we don't know exactly which kittens we'll receive until the day of the transport, we assign kittens to fosters based on factors like your experience level, available space, and preferences (e.g., *no kittens with URI, ringworm, or bottle babies*).

CAN YOU GUARANTEE THE KITTENS WON'T HAVE ILLNESSES THAT COULD AFFECT MY PETS?

Unfortunately, no. While we do our best to honor your preferences and won't knowingly send you home with a sick kitten (*if that's something you've indicated*), we often don't know the full health status of the kittens until after arrival. Some may appear healthy but show symptoms a couple of days later. Fostering always carries the risk of potential exposure to illness for your own pets.

IS IT POSSIBLE TO SIGN UP FOR THE MEGA TRANSPORT, EVEN THOUGH I HAVE NEVER FOSTERED KITTENS BEFORE?
