

SUPERVISING DOGS & KIDS

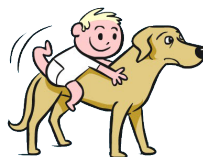

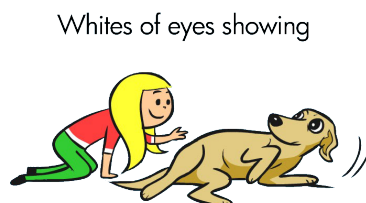
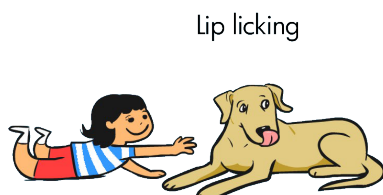
1. Tense canine body language



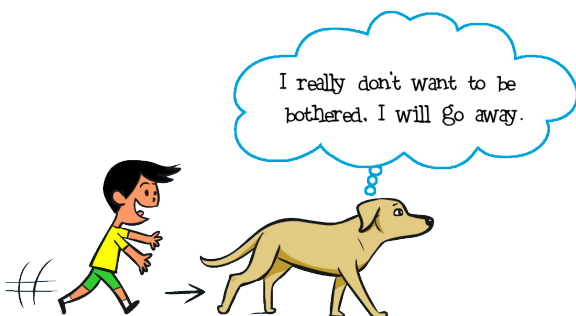
